<u>Classes</u> – Information will be coming to you over the coming days with children's classes and arrival and dismissal times. Family groups will attend on the same days. Class sizes will be at a maximum of 15 and where possible children have been placed with friendship groups.

<u>Class teachers</u> – At this stage we are unable to place teachers with classes. If Government rules change we need to re-classify the whole school making changes to allocated teachers, this would cause greater anxiety in an already very difficult period for our children.

<u>Entry/Dismissal/Lining up</u> - Staggered arrival and departure times will be sent with the above noted information. Each group will be given an allocated space for lining up, a space in the dining hall and seating in the class

<u>Playtime</u> – We will have staggered lunch and play times with each class group having a designated area of the playground.

After School Care - To date we have received no updated information regarding after school care

<u>Hygiene</u> – On entry to the school and at all transitions points the children will hand sanitise and wash their hands.

Masks/Gloves – Children are not required to wear masks or gloves in school

<u>School Office</u> – During the current period and in order to comply with Social Distancing Guidance, access to the school premise is limited to authorised persons only. **Parents/carers, contractors etc should not access the school premise unless absolutely necessary.**

Only 2 people are permitted in the area of the school office under social distancing rules. With the restricted movement within the school the office staff will not be permitted to take forgotten items to classes.

<u>Blended learning</u> - Blended Learning is easy to use home learning materials which are intended to support and complement, but not replicate, in-school learning. The learning in school will be extended and enhanced by activities and programmes in which children can participate when learning at home

<u>Hubs</u> – Key workers can apply to send their children to Hubs on the days they are not at school. Information for this will be updated on https://www.glasgow.gov.uk/coronavirus under schools and learning

<u>Uniforms</u> – Children will return to school wearing their full school uniform. We have a supply of uniforms that we can give to families. Please contact Mrs Ryan who will support you with this. The attached link is the application information for clothing grants https://www.glasgow.gov.uk/schoolsandlearning

<u>PE</u> – Good health and wellbeing is fundamental to ensuring that children can engage effectively in their learning and for that reason children will have one hour of physical activity while in school – arrangement for PE kit will be given to your child on their return to school.

<u>Primary 1</u> – Questions regarding the new P1 intake are in the pack given to parents. These can also be found on the school app and school website. On the first day parents will be given additional information.

<u>Breakfast Club</u> – Breakfast Club will be by application. Please keep looking to the attached link https://www.glasgow.gov.uk/coronavirus under schools and learning until the application forms become live

<u>Lunchtime</u> – we will update with arrangements when confirmed following current on-going discussions.

<u>Pack Lunch</u> – where possible pack lunches should be brought in a disposable bag.

<u>Pencils etc</u> – We would discourage the transfer of belongings to and from school. The school will provide all essential equipment where required.

<u>School Bag</u> – We would discourage the transfer of belongings to and from school but understand that on occasions it will be necessary to transfer appropriate items to school in a bag. Children can bring a school bag but this may change in light of advice from the Government.

<u>Reconnection -</u> On the initial return to school, teachers will plan activities which will provide opportunities for children to reconnect with school, staff and their peers and to explore their experience of lockdown

<u>Additional Support</u> – On the day your child is in school all additional support strategies will be in place as normal

<u>Breaktime/Lunchtime-</u> Teachers will talk through the new school rules and actively encourage social distancing. Playtimes and lunchtimes will be staggered and all areas of the playground, garden and pitch will be used to allow free movement and play.

<u>Toilets</u> – Children will have access to toilets for hand washing and toileting adhering social distancing rules.
